Hunter Safety Course Requirements

The Holmen Rod and Gun Club will be hosting a Hunter Safety Course this spring. The course will consist of 16 hours of classroom instruction and an 8 hour range day. All classes and the range day will be held on the Club grounds. **Students must attend all classes and the range day to be eligible to take the written exam.**

Anyone born after January 1, 1973 must successfully complete a Hunter Safety course to obtain any type of hunting license.

Following are some of the facts concerning this program.

- A. Must be 10 years old or older to take this course.
- B. Must have written permission to take this course.
- C. All classes will be held at the Holmen Rod and Gun Club on County Rd. T.**
- D. Registration for this class will be first come first serve.
- E. Parents are responsible for any needed transportation to and from the Holmen Rod and Gun Club grounds.
- F. Students are **NOT covered by any insurance through the Holmen Rod and Gun Club, the Instructors or the D.N.R.**
- G. All materials for this course will be furnished. Special arrangements may be made with the instructors to use your own firearm at the range day. If any person makes these arrangements, they are responsible for the safety and security of the firearm. All firearms are to be properly cased and unloaded. **No** personal ammunition will be allowed at the range day.
- H. The Holmen Rod and Gun Club will provide firearms for the class.
No personal firearm will be allowed in the classroom.**

Any Student disobeying the instructors will be expelled from the class

A \$ 10.00 fee will be charged for the class as per D.N.R. instructions.
